There was no one in the audience to speak.


Councilman Sebastian questioned how the list of 2017/2018 proposed street projects are created.

Mr. Vance explained that he and Jim Viox, City Engineer, tour the entire city and check the condition of the streets and then place those in need of repairs on the list.


