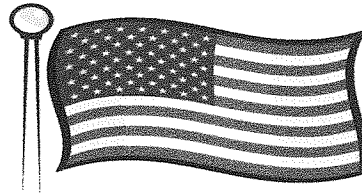

This is an annual event to assist citizens in perhaps making money on items that would be routinely disposed of. No license is needed and all fees on this annual event are waived.

Contact the city building if you wish to be placed on a participation list which will be displayed at the city building and firehouse. An ad will be placed in the newspaper indicating the participating streets provided we are notified by Monday, May 12th at noon.

WHITE GOODS DISPOSAL

The Wilder Maintenance Department will be picking up white goods such as Refrigerators, Air Conditioners, etc., which contain Freon and cannot be picked up with your regular waste collection service. If you choose to have the item picked up by Republic you must have the Freon removed and the item must have a tag stating it has been removed properly.

Any other large item can be picked up with your regular waste collection. If you do have a large item for pick-up, please contact Republic at 513-771-4200 so that they can have two people on the truck for that pick-up.

If you have a white goods item that contains Freon, you must contact the city building (581-8884) by April 9th @ 5:00 p.m., to advise of the item and to be placed on the pick-up list between 8:00 a.m. & 3:00 p.m. on April 11th.

This needs to be done so that the Maintenance Department can make proper arrangements.

Citizens Police Academy

The Campbell County Police Chiefs Association has combined efforts in conducting their consolidated citizens police academy in Northern Kentucky. Participating police agencies include Alexandria Police, Bellevue Police, Campbell County Police, Cold Spring Police, Dayton Police, Ft. Thomas Police, Highland Heights Police, Northern Kentucky University Police, Silver Grove Police, Southgate Police, and Wilder Police.

Classes will be held on Wednesday evenings beginning April 30th 2014. Applications may be obtained and submitted to your local participating police department or their website.

The citizens police academy will be a twelve-week course that citizens can attend for learning about police department and the criminal justice system. The meetings will be held at various participating police departments and will cover topics in areas of patrol functions, S.W.A.T., firearms, crime scene investigations, K-9 patrol, accident reconstruction, and criminal investigations.

There will also be guest speakers from the Campbell County Attorney's office, Commonwealth Attorney's office, Campbell County Coroner's office, Campbell County Detention Center, and the Campbell County Consolidated Dispatch Center.

Everyone is invited to submit an application to be considered for the Citizens Academy.

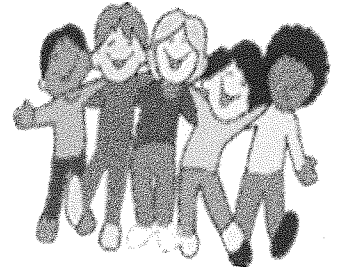
