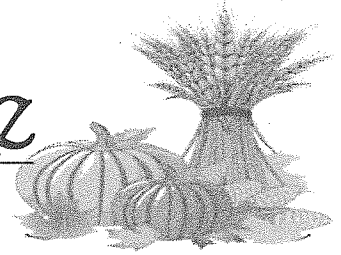

Security Alert

To help keep our city as safe as possible, we wanted to let all residents know about recent thefts and residential burglaries occurring throughout the county. Over the past few months, there has been an increase in, day time, residential burglaries, including three in Wilder.

We encourage residents to stay vigilant and always keep your homes and vehicles secure and report anything suspicious to police. Day time burglaries are surprisingly common, however, most people associate them with night. In the day, it is easy to overlook suspicious activity and thieves know this as well. Generally, they will knock on a door and once they are sure the resident is not at home, they will break in. It may only take two or three minutes to gather numerous valuable items and they're gone. Main items being stolen are jewelry, money, prescription medication and other small valuable items, which they can quickly remove and remain unnoticed.

We would be happy to provide suggestions to anyone who may have security concerns. Please understand, we must work together to keep Wilder safe. Also, check our Facebook page for updates and other important information. When calling, understand, we are not always in the office to answer. 
Ordinances and Resolutions

Ordinance #13-0901

An ordinance levying an ad valorem tax rate for the year of 2013 and setting the waste collection/recycling rate for 2013 on all property in the City of Wilder, KY, levying an ad valorem tax rate on motor vehicles for 2013 in the City of Wilder, KY, establishing the rates therefore and adopting the Campbell County Tax commissioner's assessment on said property and providing for a tax lien against all taxable property in the City of Wilder, Kentucky to secure the payment of said taxes.

The City of Wilder has two zip codes that are shared with multiple cities. Insurance premium taxes are sent based on zip codes. Please check with your auto/home insurance to be sure Wilder is receiving your tax dollars. If you have any questions please contact city hall.
